



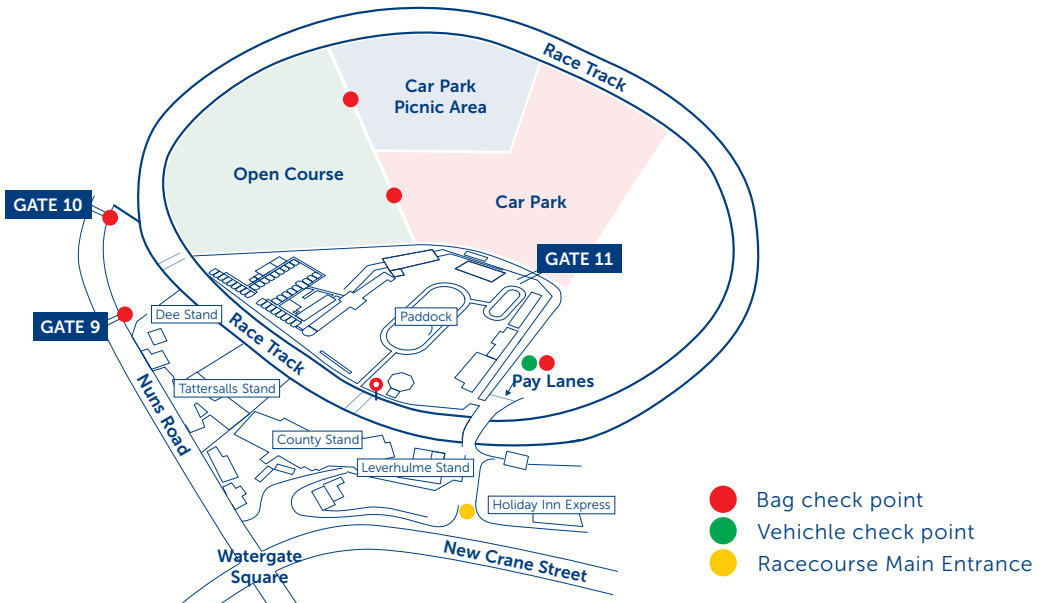
INFORMATION ABOUT THE OPEN COURSE

Racegoer safety and enjoyment is of utmost importance on racedays. Please ensure you read the following information carefully before leaving for your day at the races.

The Open Course is separated into three areas, highlighted on the map below. Racegoers arriving on foot can enter via Gates 9.

Those arriving by car can park on the car park area of the Open Course. Entrance to the Car Park on the main vehicle entrance to the Racecourse. Racecourse stewards will direct you on arrival.

Racegoers wishing to enjoy a picnic by their car before entering the Open Course will be directed to a specific area of the Car Park – the Car Park Picnic Area.

Picnics consumed in the car park picnic area may contain a moderate amount of alcohol for personal consumption. Any alcohol deemed excessive may be confiscated and disposed of.

BBQs ✓

Gazebos ✓

(at an additional cost)

Please be aware that bag checks and vehicle searches will be in operation at all entrances to the Racecourse on a raceday. Chester Race Company will refuse entry to anyone bringing alcohol into the Racecourse on foot and reserves the right to ask anyone attempting to bring alcohol onto the Open Course to leave.

Please act responsibly and be respectful of the rules, the Open Course policy is for the benefit of racegoers of all ages and their enjoyment.
