



North Wales' only racecourse ...

Guaranteeing loyal crowds and a warm friendly atmosphere, Bangor-on-Dee is North Wales' only racecourse, situated in the County of Wrexham and nestled in picturesque countryside.

Hosting jumps racing since 1859, this left-handed course is unique in character – being the only racecourse in the UK not to have a grandstand – and has a strong, race-loving community.

Many of the top trainers send their horses to race at Bangor-on-Dee as part of their education, with a number of previous winners at the course going on to win the Grand National or Grade 1 races at Cheltenham.

Consistently awarded Gold Standard status by the Racehorse Owners' Association (ROA), the racecourse aims to deliver memorable raceday experiences for all who visit.

Across 13 fixtures in 2024, staged from February to December, the racecourse has a variety of themes associated with its racedays, including family-focused events and occasions with a specific community focus.

Helping to introduce new audiences to what is a relaxed day out at the races, themed racedays can also be enriched with hospitality experiences in the Wynnstay and Paddock Restaurants, while private spaces can be booked for corporate dining and entertaining. Outside of racedays, the racecourse is also an idyllic spot to host meetings, conferences, celebrations and events.
