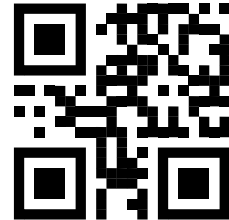

### DRESS CODE

Each enclosure at Chester Racecourse adheres to a specific dress code policy. Take care to read the dress code policy in your chosen enclosure on the Plan Your Visit section of the Chester Racecourse website. You will find a detailed guide to the dress codes and some useful hints and tips on dressing for a race day. Please note that racegoers who do not adhere to the required dress code may be refused access to the Racecourse.

### CHILDREN

Children under the age of 18 are admitted free of charge into all areas (except the Winning Post and Edinburgh Gin Garden Enclosures), when accompanied by a full paying responsible adult. No tickets are necessary, however, children entering the County Enclosure or County Long Room will require a junior badge which will be given at gate entry on the day of racing. ### FIRST AID

There are two First Aid posts situated on the Open Course and one in the Dee Stand. The main Medical Centre is located in the Holiday Inn Express Car Park.

### ACCESSIBLE FACILITIES

Accessible route into the racecourse is via gate 4. Accessible racegoer viewing facilities are provided in the County, Tattersalls, Paddock & Dee Stands. Accessible toilets are available in all areas and enclosures of the course. The Accessible Reception Area is located adjacent to the Weighing Room. Aide dogs are welcome.

### GETTING HERE

Address: The Racecourse, Chester, CH1 2LY (If using Sat nav please use CH1 4LZ) Chester Racecourse is located in the heart of the historic city of Chester. The racecourse is easily accessible by public transport, including the rail network and road and is sign-posted from all major routes.

### PARKING

Parking is included within all hospitality packages (1 pass per 2 persons). Car parking is located on the Open Course which can be accessed through the Paddock via Gate 11. Tickets will be scanned at the gate.

### FIRST RACE TIMES

Approximately 2pm on race days, 1:30pm on Boodles May Festival race days and 6pm on race evenings. Gates open approximately 2 hours before the first race. Please visit [chester-races.com](http://chester-races.com) for fixture specific times.

On arriving at the racecourse, please refer to the directional signage or ask a steward to be directed to the relevant gate for entry to the course. Please be aware that there may be queues on arrival. If you are carrying a bag, it will be checked by a member of our security team. We advise only bringing a bag if it is essential, we do not offer storage facilities. Please note, times are approximate only. Visit [chester-races.com](http://chester-races.com) for confirmed times prior to raceday.
